18 An ordinance authorizing participation in the City of
19 Slidell's health insurance program by retired City employees.

21 WHEREAS, the City of Slidell has a participatory
22 health insurance program for its employees; and

24 WHEREAS, the City of Slidell is presently paying sixty
25 per cent (60%) of the cost for eligible employees; and

27 WHEREAS, the City of Slidell desires to attract career
28 minded employees; and

30 WHEREAS the Mayor's Salary Review Committee and the
31 Slidell Civil Service Board has recommended including retired
32 City employees in the insurance program.

34 NOW, THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED that the Slidell City
35 Council does hereby authorize the participation of retired City
36 employees and retired elected city officials in the City of
37 Slidell's health insurance program under the following

Effective January 1, 1988, an individual or elected city official who has retired from City employment or service after a minimum of ten (10) years of service and who is an Annuitant under either of the two (2) retirement plans authorized by the City may elect to participate in a City sponsored health care plan with the City paying its current contributory amount, as it may change from time to time, for the individual or family coverage elected by the retiree.
 2. This benefit is extended to qualifying survivors who are drawing a qualified pension check in the name of a retiree who is deceased. The level of coverage and thus the amount of premium support will be adjusted to the


supplemental level upon the retiree's (or his/her eligible survivor's) qualification for Medicare coverage.


3. This benefit is extended to any elected official of the City of Slidell who has served a minimum of ten (10) years and who is ~~an Annuitant~~ ^{rec' benefits} under another State of Louisiana retirement plan, thereby making him/her ineligible for participation in the City of Slidell's retirement program.
