## ORDINANCE NO. 2179

An ordinance authorizing the renaming of Salmen Park to Veterans Park.

Whereas, the Slidell City Council has received a request from the St. Tammany Parish Sheriff's Office to rename Salmen Park as Veterans Park; and

Whereas, it would become a permanent place to honor St. Tammany Parish Veterans, and

Whereas, the St. Tammany Parish Sheriff's Office would like to hold a dedication of the park on May 21, 1988, Armed Services Day.

Now, Therefore Be It Ordained by the Slidell City Council that the park known as Salmen Park is hereby renamed Veterans' Park with its location more full described as follows:

That certain tract or parcel of ground, together with all buildings and improvements hereon, designated as Square 37 and part of Square 34 in the Fractional Northwest one-quarter (\(\frac{1}{4}\)\) of Section 15, Township 9 South, Range 14 east, in the City of Slidell, Parish of St. Tammany, State of Louisiana, which said squares have been sometimes known and referred to as situated in the Robert Addition to said City of Slidell, together with a strip of ground 60 feet in width forming an extension of Bryan street immediately North of and adjacent to said square 37; all in accordance with Survey No. 5313 by J. V. Burkes, C. E., dated February 19, 1968, a copy of said survey being hereto annexed and made part hereof. Said tract of ground is bounded North by the northern line of section 15, Township 9 South, Range 14 East, East by third Street, South by Cleveland Avenue and West by Second Street.

Being the same property acquired by Fritchie Bros., Inc. from Salmen Brick & Lumber Company Ltd. per deed dated April 1, 1939 and recorded in COB 143 folio 450 of the records of St. Tammany Parish, Louisiana.
