ORDINANCE NO. 2186

An ordinance of the City of Slidell which shall set forth and designate the adjusted millage rates as required by Paragraph B of Section 23, Article VII of the Constitution of Louisiana, for the purpose of maintenance and operation of the Police Department, Garbage Collection, Sewer System, Public Works, General Government, as well as providing for the payment of interest and principal on outstanding general obligation bonds, in said City for the year 1989.

SECTION 1. BE IT ORDAINED by the Slidell City Council of the City of Slidell, Louisiana, in legal session convened, that there is hereby levied an aggregate tax of thirty six and seventy one hundredths (36.71) mills on the dollar upon all property taxable, under the laws of the State of Louisiana, situated in said City, according to the assessment roll of said City in the year 1988.

SECTION 2. BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED that said aggregate tax is composed of the following individual authorized tax levys: A tax of 6.11 mills for the purpose of raising and providing sufficient revenues to pay and defray the expenses of the municipal government and for the general municipal and local purposes in the City of Slidell, Louisiana, for the year 1989, as shown by the budget for the year 1989, adopted by the City Council of said City. So authorized by Louisiana Constitution Article VI, Section 27 at 6.11 mills.

A tax of <u>3 mills</u> for the purpose of maintenance and operation of the Municipal Police Department in the City of Slidell, Louisiana, for the year 1989. So authorized by the special taxpayer election held in the City of Slidell, Louisiana, November 16, 1985.

A tax of 2.50 mills for the purpose for the purpose of maintenance and operation of the Municipal Police Department in the City of Slidell, Louisiana, for the year 1989. So authorized by the special taxpayer election held in the City of Slidell, Louisiana, April 4, 1981.
