15 An ordinance amending Chapter 9 Crimes - Miscellaneous,
16 Section 9-52 Adoption of Highway Regulatory Act of State of
17 Louisiana of the Code of Ordinances of the City of Slidell relative
18 to cargo covers.
19

20 WHEREAS, the City of Slidell presently enforces the
21 provisions of the Highway Regulatory Act of the State of
22 Louisiana which regulates streets, highways, or public ways
23 located within the City of Slidell; and
24

25 WHEREAS, the Slidell Police Department desires that
26 all trucks of one and one-half (1-1/2) tons and over travel
27 in the right lane, unless otherwise directed, maintain a
28 distance of two hundred (200') feet between trucks and have a
29 cover properly secured.
30

31 NOW, THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED by the Slidell City
32 Council that all trucks of one and one-half (1-1/2) tons and
33 over travel in the right lane of traffic on four (4) lane
34 highways, and maintain a distance of two hundred (200') feet
35 between trucks.
36

37 BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED that all sand and gravel trucks
38 exceeding one and one-half (1-1/2) tons have covers properly
39 secured over their cargos. Said cargo covers shall be of a canvas
40 or nylon tarpaulin type material, and shall be non-porous in nature.
