ORDINANCE NO. 2207

An ordinance amending Chapter 9 Crimes - Miscellaneous, Section 9-52 Adoption of Highway Regulatory Act of State of Louisiana of the Code of Ordinances of the City of Slidell relative to cargo covers.

WHEREAS, the City of Slidell presently enforces the provisions of the Highway Regulatory Act of the State of Louisiana which regulates streets, highways, or public ways located within the City of Slidell; and

WHEREAS, the Slidell Police Department desires that all trucks of one and one-half (1-1/2) tons and over travel in the right lane, unless otherwise directed, maintain a distance of two hundred (200') feet between trucks and have a cover properly secured.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED by the Slidell City Council that all trucks of one and one-half (1-1/2) tons and over travel in the right lane of traffic on four (4) lane highways, and maintain a distance of two hundred (200') feet between trucks.

BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED that all sand and gravel trucks exceeding one and one-half (1-1/2) tons have covers properly secured over their cargos. Said cargo covers shall be of a canvas or nylon tarpaulin type material, and shall be non-porous in nature.
