WHEREAS, the enactment of an ordinance in each instance would delay public projects,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED that the Mayor or his authorized representative is hereby authorized to negotiate servitudes on behalf of the City.

BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED that the Mayor is authorized to acquire servitudes on behalf of the City without further authorization from the Council provided that the cost of the servitude does not exceed \$3,000.00 and further provided that the owner of the property is not an employee or public official of the City government;

BE IT FURTHER CRDAINED that any acquisition of servitudes by the City prior to the effective date of this ordinance are herely ratified.






SKETCH OF A CERTAIN PARCEL OF LAND CERTIFIED TO SECTION 23-T95-RIAE
