", or shall be a graduate from any state licensed trade school with three (3) years of experience in that class of occupation or business governed by the license for which applicant is being made."

Paragraph (9) Requirements for applying for a license;

After the last sentence in Item d, add the following:

"Any person who is a graduate from an accredited
