ORDINANCE NO. 2240

An ordinance amending the zoning ordinances for the City of Slidell to allow dry cleaning establishments as a permitted use under C-2 zoning classifications.

WHEREAS, the Slidell City Administration has proposed an amendment to the zoning codes of the City of Slidell to permit dry cleaning establishments as a permitted use under C-2 zoning classification; and

WHEREAS, the Planning and Zoning Commission has favorably recommended said change.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED by the Slidell City Council that Appendix A-Zoning Sections 2.1601 of the Code of Ordinances of the City of Slidell, be expanded to permit dry cleaning establishments as an allowable business under C-2 zoning classifications as follows:

After the last sentence add "Retail dry cleaning drop off and pick-up stations, dry cleaning shops employing facilities for the cleaning and pressing of dry goods for retail trade only, and as approved by the Fire Marshall."


