14 **ORDINANCE NO. 2242**  
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16  
17 An ordinance providing for right-of-way encroachment  
18 under unusual circumstances.  
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20 WHEREAS property owners have from time to time  
21 approached the City of Slidell to erect barrier type traffic  
22 control devices on city rights-of-way; and

25 WHEREAS these residents have had an unusually large  
26 number of reported property damaging incidences.  
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29 NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED by the Slidell City Council  
30 that Chapter 15 Streets, Sidewalks and Public Improvements\* is  
31 hereby expanded to provide a new subsection to Article III  
32 Construction Requirements as follows:  
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36 Add: "Division 5. Approved Right-of-way Encroachments.  
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39 Section 15-75. General Requirements.  
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41 The City of Slidell shall permit encroachment into City  
42 right-of-way for the construction of barrier type  
43 traffic control devices by property owners who have had  
44 a minimum of three (3) reported cases of property damage  
45 to the Slidell Police Department within one (1) year.  
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48 The damage to the property must be caused by vehicles as  
49 determined by the Police Department.  
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52 Section 15-76. Street Right-of-way Only.  
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54 Traffic control barriers shall be allowed on city owned  
55 street rights-of-way, only after meeting all conditions  
56 herein set forth; and said encroachments shall not apply  
57 to utility easements.  
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60 Section 15-77. Approval, Design, and Acceptance.  
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62 Proposed barrier designs shall be submitted to the  
63 city's Engineering Department for review and approval  
64 prior to installation or construction.  
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13 Plans must be detailed and shall be presented on  
14 a legal survey of the property. Barriers shall be  
15 constructed of wood materials only, and shall have  
16 distinctive reflective markings. Concrete and/or metal  
17 barriers, and permanent fencing are hereby prohibited.

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19 The City Engineer, or his designee, shall inspect  
20 the completed installation and shall have authority for  
21 final approval.

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23 Section 15-78. Property Owners Responsibility.

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25 It shall be the responsibility of the property owner to  
26 execute a 'Hold Harmless Agreement' with the City of  
27 Slidell. Said property owner must show proof of current  
28 liability insurance.


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30 If it becomes necessary for the city to perform  
31 work within any right-of-way upon which barriers are  
32 erected, it shall be the property owners responsibility  
33 to remove, replace or repair any barriers which the  
34 city shall deem necessary.



37 at least seventy-two (72) hours prior to beginning  
38 construction requesting identification of underground  
39 utility locations."
