

26 that the Mayor or his representative is authorized to purchase
27 from Mapco Petroleum, Inc., the following described utility



33 A certain parcel of land situated in Sections 23 and 44,
34 Township 9 South, Range 14 East, St. Tammany Parish,
35 Louisiana, being more fully described as follows:

37 From the intersection of the Easterly Right-of-Way Line
38 of Hudson Avenue and the Northerly Right-of-Way Line
39 of Old Spanish Trail (Louisiana State Highway No. 433),
40 go North 49 degrees, 01 minutes, 00 seconds East 80.00
41 feet along said Easterly Right-of-Way Line to the
42 Southerly Right-of-way Line of a road; thence along said
43 Southerly Right-of-Way Line East 271.2 feet to a point
44 on the Westerly Right-of-Way Line of Interstate Highway
45 10; thence along said Right-of-Way Line South 32
46 degrees, 28 minutes West 23.7 feet to the Point of
47 Beginning. Thence, continue along said Westerly Right-
48 of-Way Line South 32 degrees, 28 minutes West 181.70
49 feet to a point; then South 82 degrees, 58 minutes West
50 25.93 feet to a point; thence North 32 degrees, 28
51 minutes East 184.46 feet to a point; thence East 23.71
52 feet to the Point of Beginning. Containing in all 0.084
