## ORDINANCE NO. 2250

An ordinance amending Ordinance No. 2206 to add an exemption for professional artist to the City of Slidell's public bid policy.

WHEREAS, the City of Slidell has a policy requiring the solicitation of proposals for professional services which exceeds three thousand dollars (\$3,000); and

WHEREAS, from time to time professional artists are contracted for by the City of Slidell.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED by the Slidell City Council that Ordinance No. 2206 is hereby amended as follows:

Delete lines 29 through 42 and replace with the following:

"Except for contracts entered into by the City concerning performances by professional artists, exhibitors, or performing arts groups, the City of Slidell shall publicly solicit proposals for all professional services exceeding three thousand dollars (\$3,000) to be rendered to the City of Slidell including but not limited to all City insurance coverages, engineering services, legal services, accounting and auditing services, and all other professional services to be contracted for by the City of Slidell."
