15 An ordinance amending Chapter 7 Buildings of the Code of
16 Ordinances of the City of Slidell to provide for sanitation and
17 maintenance of swimming pools.

19 BE IT ORDAINED by the Slidell City Council that Chapter
20
21 7 Buildings of the Code of Ordinances of the City of Slidell is
22
23 hereby amended as follows:

24
25 Article VIII. Swimming Pool Code* add the following section:

26
27 "Sec. 7-103. Sanitation and Maintenance.

28
29 Swimming Pools shall be maintained in a safe
30
31 and sanitary condition. All pools, equipment and
32
33 accessories, including fences, shall be safe and
34
35 free of defects. Swimming pool maintenance shall
36
37 include, the draining and/or chemical and equipment
38
39 maintenance of the pool to prevent stagnation. The
40
41 above shall be the responsibility of the owner,
42
43 occupant, or agent of the residence.

44
45 (a) A Building Permit for a swimming pool shall not
46
47 be issued until it is determined by the Building
48
49 Inspector that a fence meeting the requirements
50
51 of the Swimming Pool Code is installed or
52
53 existing on the site with the exception of that
54
55 part of the fence that must be left open to
56
57 provide access for pool construction."
