ORDINANCE NO. 2283

An ordinance amending Chapter 7 Buildings, of the Code of Ordinances of the City of Slidell to require Building, Plumbing/Gas, Electrical and ACHMRV Contractors to carry liability insurance, display license, and to allow for an inactive license.

BE IT ORDAINED by the Slidell City Council that Chapter 7 Buildings, is hereby amended as follows:

Article I. In General, is hereby amended by adding subsection 7-8.1. as follows:

"Sec. 7-8.1. Contractors public liability insurance requirement.

Each and every Building, Plumbing/Gas, Electrical and ACHMRV Contractor shall be required to carry public liability insurance in the amount of at least fifty thousand (\$50,000) dollars. No license shall be issued until proof of insurance is furnished."

Article II. Mechanical Code*, is hereby amended as follows:

Section 103.3 delete the language "License fees,

expiration and renewal." and replace with "License;

fees, expiration, renewal, and inactive license."

Section 103.3 add subparagraph (3) as follows:

"(3) A person who has been qualified for a mechanical/
gas license, but who does not desire to use his
license in such business for a given year, may take
out an inactive license. The cost of which shall
be fifty (\$50.00) dollars due January 1 of each
calendar year. Public liability insurance shall
not be required during the period in which an
inactive license is issued."

Section 103.3 add subparagraph (4) as follows: "(4) Display of License.

Slidell license number. The letters shall be at least two (2) inches in height on both sides of the vehicle.

(2) Every job being conducted requiring a permit shall have displayed a sign plainly visible from the street. The sign shall have displayed on it the company name, telephone number, and Slidell license number. This sign shall not be placed in the right-of-way. The letters on the sign shall be at least two (2) inches in height."

Article VI. Plumbing and Gasfitting*, is hereby amended as follows:

Section 7-69, delete the language "License; fees, expiration and renewal." and replace with the following language "License; fees, expiration, renewal, and inactive license."

Section 7-69, add the following subparagraphs:

- "(c) A person who has been qualified for a plumbing/gas license, but who does not desire to use his license in such business for a given year, may take out an inactive license. The cost of which shall be one hundred dollars (\$100.00) due January 1 of each calendar year. Public liability insurance shall not be required during the period in which an inactive license is issued.
 - (d) Display of License.
 - (1) Every licensed Plumbing and Gasfitting person, firm, company or corporation shall identify all his service and installation vehicles with the name of the company, telephone number, and Slidell license number. The letters shall be at least two (2) inches in height on both sides of the vehicle.

(2) Every job being conducted requiring a permit shall have displayed a sign plainly visible from the street. The sign shall have displayed on it the company name, telephone number, and Slidell license number. This sign shall not be placed in the right-of-way. The letters on the sign shall be at least two (2) inches in height."
