An ordinance amending Ordinance No. 2242 which provides for right-of-way encroachments under unusual circumstances.

BE IT ORDAINED by the Slidell City Council that Ordinance No. 2242 which provides for right-of-way encroachments under unusual circumstances within the City of Slidell is hereby amended as follows:

Page 1, line 59, after the word "barriers" add "and flag poles".

Page 1, line 65; after the word "easements." add the following language "Timbers, railroad ties, logs, and concrete bumpers used to protect city right-of-ways installed along the side of the roadways are not considered barriers under this ordinance and are exempt as long as they do not exceed six (6) inches in height. Hold harmless agreements with homeowners are left to the discretion of the Mayor."

Page 2, line 23, delete "The" at the beginning of the sentence and replace with "The Chief of Staff, the".
