22 Ordinance No. 2242 which provides for right-of-way encroachments

24 under unusual circumstances within the City of Slidell is hereby

26 amended as follows:

28 Page 1, line 59, after the word "barriers" add "and flag

30 poles".

32 Page 1, line 65, after the word "easements." add the
33
34 following language "Timbers, railroad ties, logs,
35
36 and concrete bumpers used to protect city right-of-ways
37
38 installed along the side of the roadways are not
39
40 considered barriers under this ordinance and are exempt
41
42 as long as they do not exceed six (6) inches in height.
43
44 Hold harmless agreements with homeowners are left to the
45
46 discretion of the Mayor."

48 Page 2, line 23, delete "The" at the beginning of the
49
50 sentence and replace with "The Chief of Staff, the".
