ORDINANCE NO. 2294

An ordinance deleting the provision of Sec. 9-50 Minors under the age of seventeen (17) not permitted in pool or billiard halls of Chapter 9 Criminal Code of the Code of Ordinances of the City of Slidell.

WHEREAS, Louisiana State law has provisions governing minors access to pool and billiard halls where alcoholic beverages are sold; and

WHEREAS, the City of Slidell has family amusement centers in which the games of pool and billiards are played and no alcoholic beverages are served; and

WHEREAS, many bowling establishments and other similar businesses have pool and/or billiard tables, but said games are not the primary purpose of the business.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED by the Slidell City Council that Sec. 9-50 Minors under the age of seventeen (17) not permitted in pool or billiard halls. of Chapter 9 Criminal Code of the Code of Ordinances of the City of Slidell is hereby deleted and replaced with the following:

"Sec. 9-50. Minors under the age of eighteen (18) not permitted in certain establishments where pool or billiards is played.

The following sections of the State Alcoholic

Beverage Control Law (as may be hereafter amended) are
adopted by reference and are made part of this section
insofar as they apply to municipalities, each reference
being the Louisiana Revised Statutes:

R.S. 26:90(10), and

R.S. 26:286(10)."
