ORDINANCE NO. 2301

An ordinance amending Chapter 18 Taxicabs* of the Code of Ordinances of the City of Slidell requiring taxicab services to be licensed by the City.

BE IT ORDAINED by the Slidell City Council that Chapter 18 Taxicabs* of the Code of Ordinances of the City of Slidell is hereby amended by adding the following sections:

"Sec. 18-7. Pickup service, unlawful unless licensed in the City.

It shall be unlawful for any person operating any motor vehicle used in a taxicab service, who is not licensed in the city and does not maintain a station within the city, to provide pickup service for citizens within the city. Round trip pickups will be allowed when the charge for services are paid in advance and the taxicab service waits for the customer at a designated location within the city.

Sec. 18-8. Enforcement.

The provisions of this chapter shall be subject to enforcement by the Slidell Police Department."

BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED as follows:

1. Sec. 18-2. Occupational license required. is hereby deleted and replaced with the following:

"Sec. 18-2 Taxicab license required.

It shall be unlawful to operate a taxicab or taxicab business unless a taxicab license therefore has been obtained. The taxicab license shall be prominently displayed in the vehicle at all times. The fee for the license shall be ten dollars (\$10.00) for each taxicab per calendar year."
