ORDINANCE NO. 2318

An ordinance amending Chapter 3 Alcoholic Beverage Control to allow new businesses to obtain a temporary liquor license.

WHEREAS, new businesses frequently request a temporary liquor license after all certifications are obtained and fees are paid; and

WHEREAS, Slidell City Council meets every second and fourth Tuesday of each month; and

WHEREAS, there is a two (2) or three (3) week period between Council meetings; and

WHEREAS, a temporary liquor license would assist new merchants in starting their businesses.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED by the Slidell City Council that Chapter 3 Alcoholic Beverage Control of the Code of Ordinances of the City of Slidell, Section 3.6. Temporary licenses., is hereby rescinded and reenacted as follows:

"Upon the request of the applicant, and with the approval of the Council President, a temporary liquor license shall be issued for a period of up to thirty-five (35) days to new or ongoing businesses provided the business meets all of the requirements of Sections 3.8 and 3.9 herein contained. Such temporary licenses shall be issued on a probationary basis. Permanent Licenses shall be issued upon favorable findings after proper investigations as required by Sections 3.8 and 3.9 and final action by the City Council. If a permanent license is denied, all fees shall be forfeited."
