ORDINANCE NO. 2330

An ordinance establishing a new chapter in the Code of Ordinances of the City of Slidell to be known as Chapter 12 3/4 Police Department.

WHEREAS, the City of Slidell has received a study concerning the management and operation of the Slidell Police Department from the International Association of Chiefs of Police (I.A.C.P.); and

WHEREAS, said report contains many recommendations for policy and/or procedural changes within said police department.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED by the Slidell City Council that a new chapter entitled Police Department is hereby established within the Code of Ordinances of the City of Slidell as follows:

"Chapter 12 3/4

Police Department

Sec. 12 3/4-1. Legislative intent.

It is the intent of the governing authority of the City of Slidell to enact policies and procedures for the management and operation of the Slidell Police Department. Sec. 12 3/4-2. Prohibitions.

No member of the Slidell Police Department shall assist the City Marshal's Office in the pursuit of its duties without the prior permission of the Chief of Police unless a Marshal's Office employee or agent encounters a situation endangering property or the safety of a person. A detailed report of every instance in which a Slidell police officer assists an employee or agent of the City Marshal's Office shall be forwarded to the Chief of Police and Mayor within forty-eight (48) hours of the incident. The report shall include the name of the person making the request, the reason why the request was made and what action was taken."
