## ORDINANCE NO. 2342

An ordinance amending Appendix A-Zoning of the Code of Ordinances of the City of Slidell regarding public hearings whenever a proposed industrial use needs DEQ or EPA approval.

WHEREAS, the Slidell Planning and Zoning Commission has issued a favorable recommendation for said changes.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED by the Slidell City Council that Appendix A-Zoning of the Code of Ordinances of the City of Slidell is hereby amended as follows:

Section 2.1901, add the following language after the last sentence: "No permits shall be issued for any use, activity or construction, which is subject to Louisiana Coastal Zone Management, Louisiana Wildlife and Fisheries, U. S. Army Corp of Engineers, Department of Environmental Quality (DEQ), and/or U.S. Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) approval, until after a public information hearing, on the proposed activity, has been conducted by the Planning Commission and all required permits and approvals have been issued by the herein stated Federal and State reviewing agencies. Planning Commission shall conduct its hearing within thirty (30) days after the submittal of building plans and site plans. Said hearings shall be conducted at their regular monthly meeting. To be exempt from these regulations the owner or applicant of the property shall obtain written verification, from each of the herein listed Federal and State agencies, that no permits or approvals are required. This hearing process in no way preempts the regulations and standards of the Zoning Ordinance or shall prevent the issuance of permits upon having obtained all required Federal, State and local approvals. The hearing is to provide a means by which

 the public can become informed about a project and to present information that may be pertinent to the project. All pertinent environmental facts will be sent to the applicable Federal and State agencies. Representative of the proposed business and the homeowners associations representatives involved shall be notified of the public hearing."

Add new sections as follows:

"Section 2.2002.1 Environmental Standards: Same as Section 2.1901.

Section 2.2102.1 Environmental Standards : Same as Section 2.1901."
