ORDINANCE NO. 2345

An ordinance declaring certain property of the City of Slidell as surplus and setting the method of disposing of same.

BE IT ORDAINED by the Slidell City Council that thirtyfour (34) water meters identified on Schedule A attached hereto and made a part hereof are hereby declared surplus property with a minimum value of five dollars (\$5.00) each.

BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED that the herein described property shall be sold to the highest bidder who shall submit a sealed bid meeting specifications or at a duly advertised public auction; the time, date and place fixed by the Mayor of the City of Slidell or his designee, who shall also establish method of payment and other specifications for bidders including deadline for removal.

BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED that the 1980 Ford Pickup, Unit Number 633, Identified as F10EUHG3530, declared surplus by Ordinance No. 2321 is hereby rescinded and returned to service for the City of Slidell.
