24 our purchasing policies as it pertains to services; and

27 WHEREAS, the Council is desirous of having public  
28 notification of all contracts and/or purchase of goods, services,  
29 and materials which exceeds five thousand dollars (\$5,000.00).  
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33 NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED by the Slidell City Council  
34 that Chapter 2 Administration Section 2-10 Central purchasing and  
35 leasing; advertising; public bidding., of the Code of Ordinances  
36  
37 of the City of Slidell is hereby amended as follows:  
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41 In subparagraph (c), after the word "any" add "contracts  
42  
43 or" then delete the word "purchases" and replace with  
44  
45 "purchase".

47 In subparagraph (c) delete "three thousand dollars  
48  
49 (\$3,000.00)" and replace with "five thousand dollars  
50  
51 (\$5,000.00)".

53 Delete "(e)" and replace with "(f)".

55 Delete "(d)" and replace with "(e)".

57 Add the following subparagraph:  
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59 "(d) The Mayor shall present a selection for services,

61 supplies, and materials to the Council, as the case may

63 be, on all matters herein contained except for auditing

34 public notification of its intent to enter into service

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
