An ordinance amending Chapter 9 Criminal Code, Sec. 9-79. Unnecessary Noise, of the Code of Ordinances of the City of Slidell.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED by the Slidell City Council. that Chapter 9 Criminal Code, Sec. 9-79. Unnecessary Noise, of the Code of Ordinances of the City of Slidell is hereby amended as follows:

Section 9-79. Unnecessary Noise., paragraph (c)

Prohibitions, subparagraph (2) Places of public
entertainment, is hereby rescinded and replace with
the following:

"(2) Places of public entertainment: In a place of public entertainment, it shall be unlawful for any person to sing or play a musical instrument individually or as a member or participant in any singing or musical instrument group or band with or without a phonograph, tape recording, loud speaker, sound amplifier or other instrument, machine or device, between 11:00 p.m. and 7:00 a.m. or to make or continue with any loud, unnecessary or unusual noise, including the singing or playing of music which either annoys, disturbs, injures or endangers the comfort, repose, health, peace or safety of others within the City of Slidell. If the sound or noise is plainly audible at a distance of one hundred (100) feet of the building, structure or vehicle in which it is located, it shall be prima facie evidence of a violation of this subsection."
