15 An ordinance enacting a new pay plan for Municipal  
16 Police Civil Service Employees.

18 WHEREAS, a pay plan study has been performed by  
19  
20 Langenhennig and Associates; and  
21

22 WHEREAS, the Police Municipal Civil Service Board has  
23  
24 approved and recommended the enactment of the Langenhennig  
25  
26 proposal; and  
27

28 WHEREAS, Ernest J. Langenhennig is available to assist  
29  
30 with specific rule requirements and implementation procedures.  
31

32 NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED that the Slidell City  
33  
34 Council does hereby approve the recommendation of the Police  
35  
36 Municipal Employees Civil Service Board and hereby approves the  
37  
38 pay scale, position reclassifications, and job descriptions,  
39  
40 identified in "Exhibit A" and attach hereto.  
41

42 BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED that each employee shall be  
43  
44 placed in his/her appropriate grade and step level as identified  
45  
46 in "Exhibit B" attached hereto, and that each employee's salary  
47  
48 shall be adjusted as so indicated, with no salary being reduced.  
49

50 BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED that the Police Municipal  
51  
52 Employees Civil Service Rules shall be amended as presented in the  
53  
54 Langenhennig proposal to reflect the intent of the Police  
55  
56 Municipal Civil Service Board.  
57

58 BE IT FINALLY ORDAINED that all ordinances or parts of  
59  
60 ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed. Provisions  
61  
62 of this ordinance shall become effective July 1, 1991.




