15 **ORDINANCE NO. 2390**

18 An ordinance amending Section 2.25 Protection of  
19 existing trees and landscaping requirements of Appendix A-Zoning  
20 of the Code of Ordinances of the City of Slidell.

21  
22 WHEREAS, the Slidell Zoning Commission has issued a  
23  
24 favorable recommendation for said amendments.

25  
26 NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED by the Slidell City Council  
27  
28 that Section 2.25 Protection of existing trees and landscaping  
29 requirements of Appendix A-Zoning of the Code of Ordinances of the  
30 City of Slidell is hereby amended as follows:  
31

33 In the first sentence of subsection 2.2501, delete the word  
34  
35 "should" and replace with "shall".

36  
37 In the first sentence of subsection 2.2503 (2) (d), delete  
38  
39 the word "should" and replace with "shall".

40  
41 In the first sentence of subsection 2.2506, delete the word  
42  
43 "should" and replace with "shall".

44  
45 In the first sentence of subsection 2.2506, delete the words  
46  
47 "whenever possible".

48  
49 In the first sentence of subsection 2.2506 (2), delete  
50  
51 "should" and replace with "shall".

52  
53 In the first sentence of subsection 2.2506 (3) delete the  
54  
55 words "should be avoided" and replace with "shall be  
56  
57 prohibited".

58  
59 In the first sentence of subsection 2.2506 (4) delete the  
60  
61 word "should" and replace with "shall".

62  
63 Add the following new paragraphs to subsection 2.2506:

64  
65 "(5) All trees to be retained shall have a perimeter  
66  
67 fencing at the extreme outer edge of the tree  
68  
69 canopy. The fencing shall be flagged with yellow  
70  
71 caution tape or yellow pennants, and shall remain  
72  
73 in place throughout the construction period. There



13 shall be no activity of any kind inside the  
14 perimeter other than hand brush clearing. No land  
15 clearing or building permits shall be issued until  
16 the perimeter of all protected trees and tree  
17 stands have been properly fenced.



24 tree shall be in violation of Section 2.25 and  
25 subject to the penalties prescribed in Section  
26 2.2509."
