20 them as permitted uses.

30 Part 2. Schedule of District Regulations Adopted, Section

32 2.4. A-1 Suburban District, in the first sentence after
33 the wording "recreational use;" add "private kennels;".

37 Part 2. Schedule of District Regulations Adopted, Section

39 2.5. A-2 Single-Family Residential, in the first
40 sentence after the wording "home occupations;" add
41 "private kennels;".

45 Part 2. Schedule of District Regulations Adopted, Section

47 2.9. A-6. Single-Family Urban, in the first sentence
48 after the wording "boat docks;" add "private kennels;".

52 Part 9. Definitions, add new definitions as follows:
53

54 "9.12a Kennel, Commercial: Any establishment within
55 the City Limits of Slidell which maintains more than
56 twelve (12) domestic animals in any combination, and
57 which is operated primarily for commercial boarding,
58 breed, buying, selling or rearing of animals. Animal
59 hospitals operated by a licensed veterinarian, pet
60 stores and animal shelters operated by a public
61 jurisdiction are hereby declared exempt from this
62 definition. Commercial kennels cannot be located in a
63 residential zone and must be located within the proper
64 commercial zone as set forth by current zoning laws of
65 the City of Slidell.

13 9.12b Kennel, Private: Any person(s) who maintains
14 more than a total of six (6) domestic animals over the
15 age of four (4) months on a residential property within
