8 ORDINANCE NO. 2435

11 An ordinance adding a new section to Chapter 11 Health
12 and Sanitation of the Code of Ordinances of the City of Slidell
13 to prohibit scavenging of recyclable material from areas within
14 the corporate limits of the City of Slidell.
15

16 BE IT ORDAINED by the Slidell City Council that Chapter
17 11 Health and Sanitation, Article II. Garbage, Trash and Junk, is
18 hereby amended by adding a new Sec. 11-36.1 as follows:

21 "Sec. 11-36.1. Prohibiting the scavenging of recyclable
22 materials.

26 (a) No person or persons, other than the current resident
27 of the property on which the items are placed, or an
28 authorized carrier, shall remove, pick up, or transfer
29 recyclable materials left at curbside. Materials left
30 at curbside in either specifically marked recovery
31 containers or any other type of container are to be
32 picked up by a designated carrier for the purpose of
33 removal of recyclable materials. Materials referred
34 to, and to be left at curbside in specifically marked
35 containers, will include recyclable materials included
36 in the City's recycling program.

39 (b) Penalty. Each removal of an item or items from a
40 location shall constitute a separate violation of this
41 ordinance. Unauthorized persons removing materials or
42 bins other than those persons designated above shall be
43 fined as follows:

47 (1) Upon first conviction of violation of this
48 ordinance, the person shall be fined twenty-five
49 dollars (\$25.00) for each such violation.

52 (2) Upon second conviction of violation of this
53 ordinance, the person shall be fined one hundred
54 dollars (100.00) for each violation.

6 (3) Upon third and subsequent convictions of violation
7 of this ordinance, the person shall be fined two
8 hundred dollars (\$200.00) for each such
9 violation."

14 BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED that all sections and provisions
15 of this ordinance be deemed separate and severable, and that in
16 the event that any one or more of the provisions of this
17 ordinance be deemed unenforceable or unconstitutional by any
18 final judgment, order or decree of any court of competent
19 jurisdiction, that such finding shall have not effect on the
20 remaining sections and provisions of this ordinance.
