9 ORDINANCE NO. 2439
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12 An ordinance for the City of Slidell which shall set
13 forth and designate the adjusted millage rates as required by
14 Paragraph B of Section 23, Article VII of the Constitution of
15 Louisiana, for the purpose of maintenance and operation of the
16 Police Department, Garbage Collection, Sewer System, Public
17 Works, General Government, as well as providing for the payment
18 of interest and principal on outstanding general obligation
19 bonds, in said City for the year 1993.
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22 SECTION 1. BE IT ORDAINED by the Slidell City Council
23 of the City of Slidell, Louisiana, in legal session convened,
24 that there is hereby levied an aggregate tax of thirty-six and
25 forty-four one hundredths (36.44) mills on the dollar upon all
26 property taxable, under the laws of the State of Louisiana,
27 situated in said City, according to the assessment roll of said
28 City in the year 1992.
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38 SECTION 2. BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED that said aggregate
39 tax is composed of the following individual authorized tax levys:
40 a tax of 6.11 mills for the purpose of raising and providing
41 sufficient revenues to pay and defray the expenses of the
42 municipal government and for the general municipal and local
43 purposes in the City of Slidell, Louisiana, for the year 1993, as
44 shown by the budget for the year 1993, adopted by the City
45 Council of said City. So authorized by Louisiana Constitution
46 Article VI, Section 27 at 6.11 mills.
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58 A tax of 3 mills for the purpose of maintenance and operation of
59 the Municipal Police Department in the City of Slidell,
60 Louisiana, for the year 1993. So authorized by the special
61 taxpayer election held in the City of Slidell, Louisiana,
62 November 16, 1985.
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70 A tax of 2.50 mills for the purpose of maintenance and operation
71 of the Municipal Police Department in the City of Slidell,
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6 Louisiana, for the year 1993. So authorized by the special
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8 taxpayer election held in the City of Slidell, Louisiana, April
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10 4, 1981.
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14 A tax of 5 mills for the purpose of garbage disposal and
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16 maintenance in the City of Slidell, Louisiana, for the year 1993.
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18 So authorized by the special taxpayer election held in the City
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20 of Slidell, Louisiana, September 27, 1986.
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24 A tax of 5 mills for the purpose of maintenance of the sewerage
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26 system of the City of Slidell, Louisiana, for the year 1993. So
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28 authorized by the special taxpayer election held in the City of
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30 Slidell, Louisiana, September 27, 1986.
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34 A tax of .13 mills for the purpose of providing an amount
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36 sufficient to pay interest and maturing bonds for the 1962 City
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38 Hall Jail City Court Improvement Bonds of the City of Slidell,
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40 Louisiana, for the year 1993, as authorized by a special
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42 taxpayers election held August 4, 1962, and by Resolution of the
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44 Mayor and Board of Aldermen of the town of Slidell, Louisiana,
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46 passed on the 6th day of August, 1962.
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50 A tax of .63 mills for the purpose of providing an amount
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52 sufficient to pay interest and maturing bonds for the 1974 Street
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54 Improvements Bonds of the City of Slidell, Louisiana, for the
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56 year 1993, as authorized by a special taxpayers election held
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58 December 15, 1973, and by a Resolution of the Mayor and
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60 Councilmen of the City of Slidell, Louisiana, passed on the 18th
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62 day of December, 1973, and January 22, 1974.
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66 A tax of 2.5 mills for the purpose of maintaining, operating, and
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68 improving public works within the City of Slidell, Louisiana, for

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6 A tax of .75 mills for the purpose of providing an amount
7 sufficient to pay interest and maturing bonds for the 1974 Road
8 Improvement Bonds of the City of Slidell, Louisiana, for the year
9 1993, as authorized by a special taxpayers election held December
10 15, 1973, and by a Resolution of the Mayor and Councilman of the
11 City of Slidell, Louisiana, passed on the 18th day of December,
12 1973, and January 22, 1974.
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22 A tax of .25 mills for the purpose of providing an amount
23 sufficient to pay interest and maturing bonds for the 1974
24 Drainage Improvement Bonds Series C of the City of Slidell,
25 Louisiana, for the year 1993, as authorized by a special
26 taxpayers election held December 15, 1973, and by a Resolution of
27 the Mayor and the Councilmen of the City of Slidell, Louisiana,
28 passed on the 18th day of December, 1973 and January 22, 1974.
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38 A tax of .76 mills for the purpose of providing an amount
39 sufficient to pay interest and maturing bonds for the 1976
40 Drainage Improvement Bonds Series A of the City of Slidell,
41 Louisiana, for the year 1993, as duly authorized by a special
42 taxpayers election held April 13, 1976, and by a Resolution of
43 the Mayor and the Councilmen of the City of Slidell, Louisiana,
44 passed on the 13th day of April, 1976, and the 25th day of May,
45 1976.
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56 A tax of 1.20 mills for the purpose of providing an amount
57 sufficient to pay interest and maturing bonds for the 1977
58 Drainage Improvement Bonds Series B of the City of Slidell,
59 Louisiana for the year 1993, as duly authorized by a special
60 taxpayers election held April 13, 1976, and by a Resolution of
61 the Mayor and the Councilmen of the City of Slidell, Louisiana,
62 passed on the 13th day of April 1976, and the 16th day of
63 November, 1976.
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
6 A tax of 1.87 mills for the purpose of providing an amount
7 sufficient to pay interest and maturing bonds for the 1977
8 Sewerage Improvement Bonds of the City of Slidell, Louisiana, for
9 the year 1993, as duly authorized by a special taxpayers election
10 held April 13, 1976, and by a Resolution of the Mayor and the
11 Councilmen of the City of Slidell, Louisiana, passed on the 13th
12 day of April 1976, and the 16th day of November, 1976.
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22 A tax of 6.74 mills for the purpose of providing an amount
23 sufficient to pay interest and maturing bonds for the 1989 Water
24 Bonds Series A, and 1989 Sewer Bonds Series B, and the 1989
25 Refunding Bonds Series C of the City of Slidell, Louisiana, for
26 the year 1993, as authorized by a special taxpayers election held
27 November 8, 1988, and by a Resolution of the Mayor and the
28 Councilmen of the City of Slidell, Louisiana, passed on the 24th
29 day of January 1989.
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
