

11 An ordinance amending Chapter 9 Criminal Code of the Code of Ordinances of  
12 the City of Slidell to provide for battery of a Police Officer as an offense against the person.

14 BE IT ORDAINED BY THE SLIDELL CITY COUNCIL that it does hereby  
15 amend Chapter 9 Criminal Code of the Code of Ordinances of the City of Slidell by adding the  
16 following new subsection.

19 Section 9-69.3 Battery of a Police Officer.

- 22 1. Battery of police officer is a battery committed without the consent of the victim  
23 when the offender has reasonable grounds to believe the victim is a police officer  
24 acting in the performance of his duty.  
25
  - 26 2. For purposes of this section, police officer shall include commissioned police  
27 officers, sheriffs, deputy sheriffs, marshals, deputy marshals, correctional  
28 officers, constables, wildlife enforcement agents, and probation and parole  
29 officers.  
30
  - 31 3. Whoever commits the crime of battery of a police officer shall be fined not more  
32 than five hundred dollars (\$500.00) and imprisoned not less than fifteen (15)  
33 days, nor more than six (6) months without benefit of suspension of sentence.


