ORDINANCE NO. 2468

An ordinance establishing a pay plan for unclassified employees for the City of Slidell and setting salaries for elected officials.

WHEREAS, the City of Slidell has established a pay plan for all its classified employees; and

WHEREAS, Langenhennig and Associates, after doing a comprehensive survey, has recommended a pay level for the elected officials and the unclassified employees, and a pay plan for unclassified employees for the City of Slidell.

BE IT ORDAINED by the Slidell City Council that it does enact a pay plan for unclassified employees with summary job descriptions, pay ranges, pay scales, placement in scales, and rules as attached hereto and made a part hereof.


BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED that the salary of the mayor shall be fifty-four thousand two hundred dollars (\$54,200.00), and that the position title "mayor" be removed from the ranges and grade scale and replaced with the word "vacant". The salary for the chief of police is set at ninety percent (90%) of the mayor's salary.

BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED that the City Council Member's salary shall be increased in accordance with the recommendation from Langenhennig and Associates and is hereby set at ten thousand five hundred dollars (\$10,500.00) per year to become effective with the new term of office on July 1, 1994.


BE IT FINALLY ORDAINED that the implementation of said pay plan shall be with the passage of this ordinance except as otherwise provided for herein.


