8 **ORDINANCE NO. 2472**  
9

10 An ordinance amending Appendix A-Zoning of the Code of Ordinances  
11 of the City of Slidell to amend the restrictions on the removal of pine trees in  
12 residential areas.  
13

14 NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED by the Slidell City Council that it  
15 does hereby amend Part 2 Schedule of District Regulations Adopted, Section 2.25.  
16 Protection of Existing Trees and Landscaping Requirements of Appendix A-Zoning of  
17 the Code of Ordinances of the City of Slidell as follows:

20

22 After Subsection 2.2502, add a new subsection as follows:  
23

24 "2.2502(a) Special restrictions for the removal of pine trees on  
25 developed residential lots or parcels.  
26

27  
28 (1) All regulations specified under Section 2.2502 shall  
29 apply except on a developed residential lot the  
30 applicant shall be given a one-time permit to  
31 remove three (3) protected pine trees that do not  
32 conform with any of the conditions specified in  
33 Section 2.2502 provided that each tree removed is  
34 replaced with a hardwood or evergreen tree having  
35 a minimum height of three feet (3'). Said  
36 replacement may be anywhere on the premises.  
37

38 (a) Penalty. A penalty of up to one hundred  
39 dollars (\$100.00) per tree may be assessed for  
40 failure to comply with the provisions of this  
41 section.  
42

43 (2) A protected pine tree may be removed if  
44


45 (a) Its branches overhang any principle structure,  
46 accessory building, driveway, or swimming  
47 pool;

- 7 (b) Its roots are damaging or threatening to cause  
8 damage to the principle structure, sidewalk,  
9 driveway, patio, or other immovable structure;  
10  
11 (c) Its roots are causing damage or threatening to  
12 cause damage to sewer or drain lines;  
13  
14 (d) It is interfering with the proper maintenance of  
15 hardwood trees."


