7 **ORDINANCE NO. 2478**

9 An ordinance amending Ordinance No. 2466 to permit shelters for victims  
10 of domestic violence in A-6 zoning districts under certain conditions.  
11

12 WHEREAS, Ordinance No. 2466 amended Appendix A-Zoning of the Code  
13 of Ordinances of the City of Slidell by creating conditional use zoning classifications.  
14

15 NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED by the Slidell City Council that  
16 Ordinance No. 2466 is hereby amended as follows:  
17

18 Page 1, line 73, add the following:  
19

20 "Shelter for Victims of  
21 Domestic Violence - - P P P P P P P"  
22

23 Page 4, line 31, add the following:  
24

25 "9.28c Shelter for victims of domestic violence: Refers to a State of Louisiana  
26 licensed residential facility, operated by a non-profit social service  
27 corporation, which serves as a temporary safe-house for victims of  
28 domestic violence and provides shelter, meals, childcare, and counseling  
29 to such victims. Such a facility may be no closer than three and one-half  
30 (3 1/2) miles to any similar facility, shall have a residential character and  
31 appearance typical of other residential structures in the area, and shall be  
32 located on a lot having no less than fifteen thousand (15,000) square feet  
33 of lot area and at least one (1) hard surfaced off-street parking space for  
34 each four (4) occupants."
