10 **ORDINANCE NO. 2491**

12 An ordinance proposing an amendment to Sections 2-01, 3-02, and 4-05 of
13 the Home Rule Charter for term limitations for the City Council Members, the Mayor, and
14 the Chief of Police for the City of Slidell.

15
16 WHEREAS, the Slidell Home Rule Charter has no limitations on the number
17 of terms the City Council Members, the Mayor, or the Chief of Police may serve.

18
19 NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED by the Slidell City Council that it
20 does hereby call an election at which there shall be submitted to the electorate of the City
21 of Slidell for its approval or rejection a certain proposal to amend Sections 2-01, 3-02, and
22 4-05 of the Home Rule Charter of the City of Slidell pertaining to the terms of the City
23 Council Members, the Mayor, and the Chief of Police, based upon one (1) of the following
24 alternative propositions.

27 Voters may only vote for one (1) of the following propositions.

28
29 Proposition No. 1) The current provisions of the Home Rule Charter regarding the
30 number of terms the City Council Members, the Mayor, and the Chief
31 of Police may serve shall remain unchanged.

32
33 Proposition No. 2) City Council Members, the Mayor, and the Chief of Police shall be
34 limited to not more than two (2) consecutive terms.



36 BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED that an approved charter change shall
37 become effective with the term of office beginning July 1, 1994.

39 BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED that nothing herein shall prohibit at-large
40 council members from seeking district council seats, or district council members from
41 seeking at-large council seats.


