ORDINANCE NO. 2500

An ordinance amending Ordinance No. 2491 to further define proposed
amendments to the Slidell Home Rule Charter regarding term limitations.

BE IT ORDAINED by the Slidell City Council that Ordinance No. 2491 is
hereby amended as follows:

Page 1, line 55, add the following:

"BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED that if Proposition No. 2 is adopted, the
Slidell Home Rule Charter shall be amended as follows:

1. Section 2-01, ¶ B, shall be amended by adding the following language
thereto: 'Effective with the term of office beginning July 1, 1994, Council
Members shall be limited to not more than two (2) consecutive terms.
Nothing herein shall prohibit an at-large member from seeking a district seat
or a district council member from seeking an at-large seat.'
2. Section 3-02 shall be amended by adding the following language thereto:
'Effective with the term of office beginning July 1, 1994, the Mayor shall be
limited to not more than two (2) consecutive terms.'
3. Section 4-05, ¶ B, shall be amended by adding the following language
thereto: 'Effective with the term of office beginning July 1, 1994, the Chief
of Police shall be limited to not more than two (2) consecutive terms.'"




