**ORDINANCE NO. 2502**

An ordinance designating certain tracts of land in the Palm Lake area as a  
Wildlife Refuge, Bird Sanctuary, and Nature Park.

WHEREAS, on August 14, 1984, Ordinance No. 1747 was enacted by the  
City of Slidell wherein 18.21 acres of land was accepted as a donation from M. P.  
Schneider, III, et al; and

WHEREAS, Ordinance No. 1810 was adopted on May 14, 1985, wherein  
the City of Slidell accepted an additional donation of 16.74 acres of land from M. P.  
Schneider, III, et al; and

WHEREAS, the conditions of the donations were a permanent dedication  
for a Nature Park or other similar purposes.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED by the Slidell City Council that it  
does hereby designate the land with property descriptions identified in Ordinances Nos.  
1747 and 1810 respectively, as a Wildlife Refuge, Bird Sanctuary, and Nature Park, and  
that no developments therein shall cause any disruptions to the herein stated purpose.




