ORDINANCE NO. 2505

An ordinance amending Appendix A-Zoning of the Code of Ordinances of the City of Slidell relative to revolving beacon and laser lights.

WHEREAS, the Slidell Planning and Zoning Commission has issued a favorable recommendation for said amendment.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED by the Slidell City Council that Section 500 Sign regulations of Appendix A-Zoning of the Code of Ordinances of the City of Slidell be amended as follows:

Subsection 502. Definitions, add the following two (2) definitions:

"502.15.1 Laser lights. A device or series of devices which emits an intense monochromatic beam of light."; and

"502.29.1 Revolving beacon: A light can or series of light cans which move or rotate in a random orbit."

Add a new subsection as follows:

"520.04 In all C and M zones, a business or non-profit organization may display a revolving beacon or laser light upon the premises where a special promotional event is being held. Each display period shall not exceed five (5) days and each business shall be permitted no more than four (4) periods per year. The revolving beacon or laser light shall be securely attached to its transporting vehicle and shall not project into the rights-of-way, or obstruct the vision of vehicles or pedestrians who may be entering or exiting the premises. Equipment used to operate this equipment shall be subject to the provision of Section 9-79 Unnecessary noise of the Criminal Code.

A special permit shall be obtain from the Permit Department for each display. The revolving beacon or laser light shall be promptly removed from the premises upon the expiration of the permit. A permit fee of twenty-five dollars (\$25.00) shall be charged for each separate period."


