10 An ordinance amending the Code of Ordinances of the City of Slidell to
11 provide for a penalty for tampering with the City's water system.
12

13 BE IT ORDAINED by the Slidell City Council that the Code of Ordinances
14 for the City of Slidell, Chapter 20 Water, Section 20-9. Tampering with system, is
15 amended to provide for a penalty as follows:
16
17

18 Section 20-9. Tampering with system. Add a new paragraph (c) as follows:

19 "(c) Obstruction or damage to meter boxes. Meter boxes are to remain free
20 of obstruction and shall not be damaged. With the approval of the Finance
21 Director or the City Engineer, willful damage or obstruction of water meters may
22 cause the resident to be assessed additional charges as follows:


24 Broken Tops	\$25.00
25 Broken valves	25.00
26 Broken locks	25.00
27 Broken lenses, (replacement of meters)	50.00
28 Oil or foreign material in meter boxes	50.00
29 Cars blocking meter boxes	25.00
30 Trash piled up on meter boxes	25.00

31 (d) Penalty. Violations of provisions of this section shall be punishable by
32 a fine of up to five hundred dollars (\$500.00) or six (6) months in jail, or both."


