## **ORDINANCE NO. 2724**

An ordinance amending the Code of Ordinances of the City of Slidell, Appendix A-Zoning, Section 526 to permit off-premise signs for banks in C-3 zoning designation (Central Business District).

NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED by the Slidell City Council that it does hereby amend Appendix A-Zoning of the Code of Ordinances of the City of Slidell, Section 526 Off-premise signs, by adding the following additional paragraph thereto:

"Section 526.05 Banks located within the C-3 zoning designation (Central Business District) and where such banks are not located on one of the following main thoroughfares: Pontchartrain Drive and Front Street (U.S. Highway 11), Old Spanish Trail (LA Highway 433), Gause Boulevard (U.S. Highway 190 East), the extension of Gause Boulevard designated as U.S. Highway 190 West, and Interstate 10 Service Roads, may erect one only off-premise sign, not to exceed four (4) feet in height and eight (8) feet in length including any frame or border, on private property located on the main thoroughfare, as named above, which is the main thoroughfare nearest to said bank, as a directional sign to assist persons in locating said bank. Copy on said sign shall contain only the name of the bank, its address, directional copy to said bank, and any emblem of an established franchise or association. The property on which such off-premise sign is located must be zoned C-3. The sign may have two (2) faces, be illuminated and its total height from ground level may not exceed twelve (12) feet. Such sign must conform with all requirements in Section 503 of this section."
