ORDINANCE NO. 2730

An ordinance amending Chapter 3 Alcoholic Beverage Control of the Code of Ordinances of the City of Slidell to exclude tax-exempt establishments with 501 (c)(19) tax designations from the location restrictions therein.

WHEREAS, the City Alcoholic Beverage Control ordinance has a provision to permit charitable, religious, or fraternal organizations which have tax exempt status under sections 501 (c)(3) or 501 (c)(8) of the U. S. Internal Revenue Service to operate an establishment within 300 feet of a church, school, etc.; and

WHEREAS, certain fraternal organizations are tax exempt under Section 501 (c)(19) of the Internal Revenue Code.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED by the Slidell City Council that it does hereby amend Chapter 3 Alcoholic Beverage Control of its Code of Ordinances for the City of Slidell, Section 3-11 Location restricted; exception.

Paragraph 2, after the language 501 (c)(3) add a "," and delete "or" and after 501 (c)(8) add the following ", or 501 (c)(19)."
