## **ORDINANCE NO. 2751**

An ordinance amending Chapter 3 Alcoholic Beverage Control of the Code of Ordinances of the City Slidell to amend the location prohibition of 300' (three hundred feet) from churches, synagogues, libraries, playgrounds, or schools.

WHEREAS, Section 3-11 of Chapter 3 Alcoholic Beverages places location restrictions on the sale of alcoholic beverages by-the-drink on all establishments except bonafide restaurants within 300' (three hundred feet) of a church, synagogue, library, playground or school; and

WHEREAS, on occasions churches have located within 300' (three hundred feet) of existing establishments licensed to sell alcoholic beverages by-the-drink.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED by the Slidell City Council that it does hereby amend Chapter 3 Alcoholic Beverage Control of its Code of Ordinances Section 3-11. Location restricted; exception as follows:

In the first paragraph delete the last sentence in its entirety and replace with the following:

"Nothing herein shall affect the renewal of a license or the obtainment of a new license of a place of business that has had a City permit to sell alcoholic beverages on the effective date of this chapter, nor shall it prohibit the issuance of a new license to another establishment provided that there is an existing alcoholic beverage licensee within 300' (three hundred feet) of said church, synagogue, library, playground, or school."
