## **ORDINANCE NO.2767**

An ordinance amending the Code of Ordinances Chapter 2 Administration of the City of Slidell to provide for an inventory of immovable property.

WHEREAS, Ordinance No. 1552 dated November 9, 1982, was adopted by the Slidell City Council; and

WHEREAS, the intent of said ordinance was to provide for an inventory of all immovable properties.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED by the Slidell City Council that it does hereby amend its Code of Ordinances Chapter 2 Administration, Section 2-15 Immovable property inventory as follows:

Delete all language and replace with the following:

"The City Attorney shall obtain a certified true copy of each deed to immovable property owned by the City of Slidell. The said deed shall be filed by the City Attorney with the Department of Planning and with the Clerk of the Slidell City Council. The Clerk shall file said deeds in the archives of the City Council. The Planning Department shall maintain and establish an inventory of all immovable properties owned by the City of Slidell and shall also include in said inventory all City of Slidell easements, right-of-ways, and servitudes. Provided, however, that immovable properties acquired by the City of Slidell at tax sales shall be exempt from the provisions of this section."
