ORDINANCE NO. 2779

An ordinance amending Ordinance 1844 which established the Suncrest Planned Unit Development (PUD) to allow for construction of decks and patios, and the installation of satellite dishes and portable swimming pools or hot tubs.

WHEREAS, certain residents in the Suncrest PUD have requested amendments to the PUD; and

NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED by the Slidell City Council that the PUD development known as Suncrest annexed into the City of Slidell by Ordinance No. 1844 is hereby amended to allow the following:

- The construction of a deck (either wooden or concrete) to be attached to the rear of the residence.
- 2. The construction of an enclosed patio to the rear of the residence to be built in accordance with the City of Slidell's current building codes and approved by the Architectural Board established by the Suncrest Homeowners Association. Additionally, all enclosed patios must meet the minimum rear yard setback of ten feet.
- 3. The installation of a satellite dish no larger than 18 inches in diameter which must be placed to the rear of the residence.
- 4. The installation of a portable swimming pool or hot tub to the rear of the residence to be placed so as not to encroach any easements previously established by the City of Slidell or to extend beyond the property line of the residence.
