ORDINANCE NO. 2934

An ordinance amending the Code of Ordinances of the City of Slidell, Chapter 3 Alcoholic Beverage Control and Chapter 17 Taxation and Licenses, to restrict the issuance of alcoholic beverage or occupational licenses to businesses with delinquent sales taxes.

WHEREAS, the City of Slidell requires an annual occupational license for any person pursuing and conducting any business, trade, calling, profession or vocation within the corporate limits of the City of Slidell in accordance with Section 17-11 of the Code of Ordinances; and

WHEREAS, the City of Slidell further requires an alcoholic beverage permit for all persons engaged in the business of dealing in alcoholic beverages in accordance with Section 3.3 of the Code of Ordinances; and

WHEREAS, these licenses must be renewed annually; and

WHEREAS, the same businesses remit sales taxes to the City of Slidell; and WHEREAS, various businesses may be delinquent from time to time in their

sales taxes to the City of Slidell; and

WHEREAS, businesses that are delinquent in their sales taxes should not be permitted to continue operations in the City without bringing delinquent sales taxes current.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED by the Slidell City Council that it does hereby amend Chapter 3 Alcoholic Beverage Control of its Code of Ordinances by adding a new section as follows:

"Sec. 3-3.1. License Prohibitions.

No alcoholic beverage license shall be issued or renewed by the City of Slidell without a verification that all City of Slidell sales taxes owed by the applicant are paid in full. The City of Slidell will provide a form to the applicant to be attached to the original or renewal application certifying that all sales tax owed the City of Slidell is paid or indicating the extent of the delinquency. The City will revoke alcoholic beverage licenses

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with any establishment doing business within the City limits and owing taxes or license fees to the City if said taxes or license fees are delinquent for sixty (60) days. The revocation may be suspended if a payment schedule is worked out with the City Finance Director's approval. If for any reason the current taxes or license fees become delinquent or a payment on a payment schedule becomes more than thirty (30) days delinquent, the payment agreement will be null and void and the current license will be revoked. The City Finance Director will notify the Slidell City Council in writing through the Council Administrator of any arrangements or revocations made by the City of Slidell and the delinquent party."

BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED that Chapter 17 Taxation and Licenses of the Code of Ordinances is hereby amended by adding a new section as follows:

"Sec. 17-11.1. Prohibition.

No occupational license shall be issued or renewed by the City of Slidell without a verification that all City of Slidell sales taxes owed by the applicant are paid in full. The City of Slidell will provide a form to the applicant to be attached to the original or renewal application certifying that all sales tax owed the City of Slidell is paid or indicating the extent of the delinquency. The City will revoke occupational licenses with any establishment doing business within the City limits and owing taxes or license fees to the City if said taxes or license fees are delinquent for sixty (60) days. The revocation may be suspended if a payment schedule is worked out with the City Finance Director's approval. If for any reason the current taxes or license fees become delinquent or a payment on a payment schedule becomes more than thirty (30) days delinquent, the payment agreement will be null and void and the current license will be revoked. The City Finance Director will notify the Slidell City Council in writing through the Council Administrator of any arrangements or revocations made by the City of Slidell and the delinquent party."
