ORDINANCE NO. 2936

An ordinance authorizing the City of Slidell to enter into a Cooperative Endeavor Agreement between the City of Slidell and the Boys & Girls Clubs of Southeast Louisiana, Inc.

WHEREAS, the City of Slidell (hereinafter referred to as "City") is authorized to enter into this cooperative endeavor for a public purpose pursuant to Constitution Article 7, Section 14; and

WHEREAS, the Boys & Girls Clubs of Southeast Louisiana, Inc. (hereinafter referred to as "Boys & Girls Clubs") are engaged in providing recreational facilities and activities to low and moderate income families and individuals residing within the City; and

WHEREAS, the City owns a certain parcel of property upon which the City had a community swimming pool constructed; and

WHEREAS, the City desires to donate the said parcel of property and the community swimming pool to the Boys & Girls Clubs in furtherance of its desire and obligation to provide recreational facilities and activities to low and moderate income persons; and

WHEREAS, the City desires to turn over to the Boys & Girls Clubs total ownership, responsibility, and operation of the community swimming pool; and

WHEREAS, the Boys & Girls Clubs desire to accept the donation of the said property and pool; and

WHEREAS, the Boys & Girls Clubs desire to own, be responsible for, and operate the community swimming pool; and

WHEREAS, the benefits to the City pursuant to this Agreement will be commensurate with its costs;

NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED by the Slidell City Council that it does hereby authorize its Mayor to enter into an agreement with the Boys & Girls

Clubs of Southeast Louisiana, Inc., according to the terms and conditions as herein below stated:

1. The City hereby gives, grants, cedes, confirms, transfers, donates, and delivers unto the Boys & Girls Clubs the following described property, towit:

Commencing at an iron rod in the southern margin of Dewey Avenue where Dewey Avenue and Fifth Street intersect, the same iron rod identifying the northeast corner of a parcel owned by the Slidell Boys & Girls Clubs, located in the City of Slidell, Parish of St. Tammany, State of Louisiana, from such iron rod proceed south along the common boundary of the Slidell Boys & Girls Clubs parcel and the City of Slidell parcel known as Possum Hollow Park 180.00 feet to a point; thence proceed east 190.00 feet to a point; thence proceed north 145.00 feet to a point; thence proceed morthwest 77.59 feet to a point; thence proceed west 73.40 feet, more or less, to a point in the east margin of Fifth Street; thence proceed south along the eastern margin of Fifth Street to the intersection of the southern margin of Dewey Avenue; thence proceed west along the margin southern margin of Dewey Avenue to that point of beginning. containing 0.86 acre, more or less.

Together with all rights, ways, privileges, advantages, and appurtenances thereunto pertaining, including, but not limited to, the community swimming pool and all its associated structures, gear, and equipment;

- 2. The Boys & Girls Clubs hereby accept the above-described donation;
- The Boys & Girls Clubs shall have total control over and responsibility for the operation and maintenance of the community swimming pool;
- 4. The Boys & Girls Clubs shall operate the community swimming pool as to serve at least fifty-one percent low and moderate income persons.
