7 **ORDINANCE NO. 2936**

9 An ordinance authorizing the City of Slidell to enter into a Cooperative
10 Endeavor Agreement between the City of Slidell and the Boys & Girls Clubs of
11 Southeast Louisiana, Inc.

12 WHEREAS, the City of Slidell (hereinafter referred to as "City") is
13 authorized to enter into this cooperative endeavor for a public purpose pursuant to
14 Constitution Article 7, Section 14; and
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16 WHEREAS, the Boys & Girls Clubs of Southeast Louisiana, Inc.
17 (hereinafter referred to as "Boys & Girls Clubs") are engaged in providing recreational
18 facilities and activities to low and moderate income families and individuals residing
19 within the City; and
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21 WHEREAS, the City owns a certain parcel of property upon which the City
22 had a community swimming pool constructed; and
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24 WHEREAS, the City desires to donate the said parcel of property and the
25 community swimming pool to the Boys & Girls Clubs in furtherance of its desire and
26 obligation to provide recreational facilities and activities to low and moderate income
27 persons; and
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29 WHEREAS, the City desires to turn over to the Boys & Girls Clubs total
30 ownership, responsibility, and operation of the community swimming pool; and
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32 WHEREAS, the Boys & Girls Clubs desire to accept the donation of the
33 said property and pool; and
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35 WHEREAS, the Boys & Girls Clubs desire to own, be responsible for, and
36 operate the community swimming pool; and
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38 WHEREAS, the benefits to the City pursuant to this Agreement will be
39 commensurate with its costs;
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41 NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED by the Slidell City Council that it
42 does hereby authorize its Mayor to enter into an agreement with the Boys & Girls
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4 Clubs of Southeast Louisiana, Inc., according to the terms and conditions as herein

6 below stated:



8 1. The City hereby gives, grants, cedes, confirms, transfers, donates, and
9 delivers unto the Boys & Girls Clubs the following described property, to-
10 wit:

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12 Commencing at an iron rod in the southern margin of Dewey
13 Avenue where Dewey Avenue and Fifth Street intersect, the same
14 iron rod identifying the northeast corner of a parcel owned by the
15 Slidell Boys & Girls Clubs, located in the City of Slidell, Parish of St.
16 Tammany, State of Louisiana, from such iron rod proceed south
17 along the common boundary of the Slidell Boys & Girls Clubs
18 parcel and the City of Slidell parcel known as Possum Hollow Park
19 180.00 feet to a point; thence proceed east 190.00 feet to a point;
20 thence proceed north 145.00 feet to a point; thence proceed
21 northwest 77.59 feet to a point; thence proceed west 73.40 feet,
22 more or less, to a point in the east margin of Fifth Street; thence
23 proceed south along the eastern margin of Fifth Street to the
24 intersection of the southern margin of Dewey Avenue; thence
25 proceed west along the margin southern margin of Dewey Avenue
26 to that point of beginning. containing 0.86 acre, more or less.

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28 Together with all rights, ways, privileges, advantages, and appurtenances
29 thereunto pertaining, including, but not limited to, the community
30 swimming pool and all its associated structures, gear, and equipment;

32 2. The Boys & Girls Clubs hereby accept the above-described donation;
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34 3. The Boys & Girls Clubs shall have total control over and responsibility for
35 the operation and maintenance of the community swimming pool;
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37 4. The Boys & Girls Clubs shall operate the community swimming pool as to
38 serve at least fifty-one percent low and moderate income persons.
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
