ORDINANCE NO. 2938

An ordinance amending Chapter 12 - Motor Vehicles and Traffic, Section 12-43. Unauthorized parking in spaces reserved for handicapped prohibited, of the Code of Ordinances of the City of Slidell to revise regulations prohibiting unauthorized parking in spaces reserved for handicapped.

WHEREAS, the City of Slidell desires to prohibit unauthorized parking in spaces reserved for handicapped.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED by the Slidell City Council that it does hereby amend Chapter 12 - Motor Vehicles and Traffic, Section 12-43. Unauthorized parking in spaces reserved for handicapped prohibited, of the Code of Ordinances of the City of Slidell, as follows:

Chapter 12 - Motor Vehicles and Traffic, Section 12-43, delete entire section and replace with the following:

- "(a) No person shall park any vehicle at a public facility in spaces for the mobility impaired unless:
 - (1) Such vehicle has a license plate for the mobility impaired which contains the word 'handicapped' embossed on the license plate or a properly displayed parking card issued pursuant to Louisiana Revised Statute 47:463.4 or 47:463.4.1; and
 - (2) Such vehicle is occupied by a person who is mobility impaired.
 - (b) Any person violating this section shall be fined the sum of two hundred seventy-five dollars (\$275.00).
 - (c) For purposes of this section, the term 'public facility' shall mean a commercial facility, a place of public accommodation, parking garage, parking lot, or street."
