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7 **ORDINANCE NO. 2944**
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10 An ordinance for the City of Slidell which shall set forth and designate the
11 adjusted millage rates as required by Paragraph B of Section 23, Article VII of the
12 Constitution of Louisiana, for the purpose of maintenance and operation of the Police
13 Department, Garbage Collection, Sewer System, Public Works, General Government,
14 as well as providing for the payment of interest and principal on outstanding general
15 obligation bonds, in said City for the fiscal year 2001.

16 SECTION 1. BE IT ORDAINED by the Slidell City Council of the City of
17 Slidell, Louisiana, in legal session convened, that there is hereby levied an aggregate
18 tax of thirty-five and sixty-nine one hundredths (35.69) mills on the dollar upon all
19 property taxable, under the laws of the State of Louisiana, situated in said City,
20 according to the assessment roll of said City in the calendar year 2000.
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22 SECTION 2. BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED that said aggregate tax is
23 composed of the following individual authorized tax levys:
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25 A tax of 6.18 mills for the purpose of raising and providing sufficient revenues to
26 pay and defray the expenses of the municipal government and for the general municipal
27 and local purposes in the City of Slidell, Louisiana, for the year 2001, as shown by the
28 budget for the year 2001, adopted by the City Council of said City. So authorized by
29 Louisiana Constitution Article VI, Section 27 at 6.18 mills.
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31 A tax of 3.0 mills for the purpose of maintenance and operation of the Municipal
32 Police Department in the City of Slidell, Louisiana, for the year 2001. So authorized by
33 the special taxpayer election held in the City of Slidell, Louisiana, November 8, 1984.
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35 A tax of 2.53 mills for the purpose of maintenance and operation of the Municipal
36 Police Department in the City of Slidell, Louisiana, for the year 2001. So authorized by
37 the special taxpayer election held in the City of Slidell, Louisiana, April 4, 1981.
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39 A tax of 5.0 mills for the purpose of garbage disposal and maintenance in the
40 City of Slidell, Louisiana, for the year 2001. So authorized by the special taxpayer
41 election held in the City of Slidell, Louisiana, November 8, 1994.
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5 A tax of 5.0 mills for the purpose of maintenance of the sewerage system of the
6 City of Slidell, Louisiana, for the year 2001. So authorized by the special taxpayer
7 election held in the City of Slidell, Louisiana, November 8, 1994.
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10 A tax of 2.53 mills for the purpose of maintaining, operating, and improving public
11 works within the City of Slidell, Louisiana, for the year 2001. So authorized by the
12 special taxpayer election held in the City of Slidell, Louisiana, April 4, 1981.
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15 A tax of 4.90 mills for the purpose of providing an amount sufficient to pay
16 interest and maturing bonds for the 1994 General Obligation Refunding Bonds of the
17 City of Slidell, Louisiana, for the year 2001, as authorized by a special election held
18 November 8, 1988, and by a Resolution of the Mayor and the Council Members of the
19 City of Slidell, Louisiana, passed on the 8th day of March, 1994.
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23 A tax of 6.55 mills for the purpose of providing an amount sufficient to pay
24 interest and maturing bonds for the 1996 General Obligation Bonds for the City of
25 Slidell, Louisiana, for the year 2001, as authorized by a special election held November
26 18, 1995, and by a Resolution of the Mayor and the Council Members of the City of
27 Slidell, Louisiana, passed on the 12th day of September, 1995.
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


