ORDINANCE NO. 2948

An ordinance establishing and setting salaries for elected officials for the City of Slidell.

WHEREAS, Section 3-06 of the Home Rule Charter provides for the Mayor of the City of Slidell to be eligible for a salary increase of not more than the average percentage of increase granted annually to all City employees; and

WHEREAS, all City employees will receive a 5.15% average percentage increase during fiscal year 2001; and

WHEREAS, the salary for the Slidell Chief of Police has been set at 90% of the salary of the Mayor; and

WHEREAS, Section 2-04 of the Home Rule Charter provides for salary adjustments for Council Members to be adopted at least one year prior to the beginning of the term of office, and said salary adjustment cannot become effective during the term of office in which it was enacted.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED by the Slidell City Council that effective July 1, 2000, the salary of the Mayor shall be set at \$78,375 and the salary for the Chief of Police shall be \$70,537.

BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED that the salary for the Council Members shall be \$15,295 per year beginning with the term of office effective July 1, 2002, and that said salaries shall be increased annually by the average percentage increase granted all City employees.
