ORDINANCE NO. 2957

An ordinance amending the Code of Ordinances of the City of Slidell, Chapter 19, Parks and Recreation, by increasing the maximum allowable appropriation to various city sports organizations.

WHEREAS, the Slidell City Council adopted Ordinance No. 1203 on September 11, 1979, limiting the contributions to various city sports organizations to Five Thousand Dollars (\$5,000.00); and

WHEREAS, the City of Slidell chooses to increase the maximum allowable appropriation for sports organizations; and

WHEREAS, one of the criteria for participation in the program was that the organization must own a physical facility of not less than three (3) acres.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED by the Slidell City Council that it does hereby amend Chapter 19, Parks and Recreation of the Code of Ordinances of the City of Slidell as follows:

Sec. 19-2. Sports assistance program.

Paragraph (a), delete "\$5,000.00" and replace with "Ten Thousand Dollars (\$10,000.00)".

Subparagraph (3), delete entire paragraph.
