ORDINANCE NO. 2960

An ordinance amending Chapter 4 Alcoholic Beverages, of the Code of Ordinances of the City of Slidell, changing the procedure for the issuance of liquor licenses to an Administrative process.

WHEREAS, the Slidell City Council desires to change the procedure for the issuance of liquor licenses by making it an Administrative process; and

WHEREAS, City Council approval is required on all liquor license revocations.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED by the Slidell City Council that it does hereby amend Chapter 4 Alcoholic Beverages, of the Code of Ordinances of the City of Slidell, as follows:

Article II. Permits, Sec. 4-21. Required.

In the first paragraph, delete the phrase, "and approval by the city council at a council meeting."

Sec. 4-23. Required for special event.

Delete subparagraph "b" in its entirety.

In subparagraph "c," delete the phrase, "Upon city council approval,".

In the second paragraph of subparagraph (2), delete the phrase, "city council" and replace with "city administration", delete the word "council" and replace with "mayor".

Sec. 4-24. Temporary permits.

In the first sentence, delete the phrase, "and with the approval of the council president,". In the second-to-last sentence, delete the phrase, "and final action by the city council".

Sec. 4-27. Requirements for approval.

In the first sentence, delete the phrase, "city council".
